Class of 2020 Commencement Update

- Based on the Ohio Department of Health and Ohio Department of Education Guidelines
- Three Component Graduation Ceremony
 - In Person Crossing the Stage - Videotape and photograph
 - In Car Ceremony - Playing a live stream of the event with diplomas distributed afterward in front of high school with LED screens. There will be plenty of parking available. 450 spaces.
 - Video of Commencement available to everyone. Will be available on U Tube at a later date.
- Thursday May 7th 6:00 p.m. - BBHCSD Class of 2020 Celebrations Zoom Town Hall. An email was sent to all families of seniors inviting them to attend this Zoom Town Hall Meeting to go over all of the details of the graduation ceremony plans for the seniors. Superintendent Magyar, Treasurer Yangilos, and Principal Ast will be in Zoom Meeting.

Prom: is postponed, but not cancelled at this point. End of summer doesn't look promising. Administration is looking into a December 19th possible solution. It was suggested that a survey of the students be conducted to see if they want a winter prom. According to social media, many do not.

- Teachers who need training on Zoom are getting it. All are getting trained in the new on-line learning technology. There has been apprehension by some staff of using on-line learning tools because of the possible misuse of the technology by others.
- Principal Ast has heard from many parents expressing strong concern for more on-line learning. He has addressed all of these concerns with the teachers. If there is still a problem then the parent should either reach out to the teacher or to Principal Ast or any of the Assistant Principals.

Cap and Gown pick up: This will be curbside pick-up Thursday, May 7th. A Josens rep has them and will be bringing them to the high school for distribution.

Submitted Questions

Question: How/when would we get a refund for what is on a lunch account for seniors, pay to play, parking fees, and other reimbursements?

Answer: There is a form that needs to be filled out and sent in to the Bd. of Ed. Treasurer's Office. Reimbursements will be sent out. The process is slow right now because there are so many reimbursements to deal with because of shutdown. People will have the option to get a credit for next year, or receive reimbursement.

Question: Are they giving the money pack to NHS students who paid for the Glow Dance?

Answer: Principal Ast will have to speak to the NHS Advisors. He's not sure about the process so he will get back to us with an answer.

Answer: Will spots be assigned for the June 13th event?

Question: Because of time constraints there will not be spots assigned, however, class officers and top 10 students will be first in-line, everyone else will fall into place as they arrive to keep things moving.

Question: Will you be asking people to turn off cars at the June 13th event? The April event when windows were down you got a lot of gas fumes. It was hard to hear what was being said.

Answer: Yes. Principal Ast heard back from people about this and he will ask that cars remain off during the ceremony.

Question: Any updates on Fall Sports Try outs, Band Camp, practices, etc.?

Answer: Everything is still on hold as of now. OHSAA closed all facilities through June 30th and it's not promising for July and even August at this point. It is a definite possibility that band camp could be postponed or even canceled. They just don't know at this point. The administration is working hard on all the "what ifs" for the upcoming fall. Principal Ast would vote for a partial season, if possible, rather than canceling everything. Principal Ast is encouraging the adults to talk positively when talking with the kids.

Question: Will seniors know if they are receiving award ahead of time for Senior Awards Night on May 20th?

Answer: Yes. An email to families will go out on Friday to let them know if their senior is receiving an award.

Question: What is going on with the pile of dirt/mud behind the band room.

Answer: Principal Ast not aware of it. He will check it out.

Question: Are middle school and K-4 buildings last day of school also May 29th?

Answer: Yes.
